

# Notice to the Public

## Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

LARC posts Title VI notices on our agency's website: [www.lacledecountyarc.org](http://www.lacledecountyarc.org); on our public bulletin boards in our agency and in all of our agency vehicles.

LARC operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by LARC, you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

### How to file a Title VI complaint with LARC:

1. To file a complaint, ask the Director for a copy of LARC's Grievance Policy. They will provide you with a copy and assist you with it if needed. A copy is also posted on our bulletin board in the front office area of our facility.
2. In addition to the complaint process at LARC, complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region 7, 901 Locust St, Suite 404, KC MO64106
3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
